## Coteaux du Vendômois Blanc "Lieu-Dit, Cocagne"





**LOCATION:** The place named "Cocagne" is located on the banks of the Loir in the commune of Lunay. The grapes grow on slopes that constitute the finest terroir in the appellation.

## **TERROIR**: Soil:

The place named Cocagne features soil consisting of clay (20 %) with Turonian limestone parent rock and a large quantity of pink flint on the surface. This terroir provides excellent water supply and drainage.

## Sun exposure:

Cocagne, is located on an east-facing slope in a part of the Loir Valley with many bends that gives the region a microclimate conducive to winegrowing.

## Climate:

Temperate climate. The vineyard is protected from northerly winds and has a microclimate conducive to grape growing thanks to the influence of the Loir river.

**WINEMAKING**: Light pneumatic pressing. 24-hour static clarification of the must. Fermentation at 14°C in temperature-controlled stainless steel vats.

AGEING: This "Lieu-Dit Cocagne" was aged on its lees for several months.

VARIETALS: Chenin 100%

**FOOD PAIRINGS**: Ideal as an aperitif or with pork, sushi, fish, seafood, goat's cheese, fruit salad, etc.
